





Mustafa Kemal (Ataturk) stated in 1919 that "The massacre and deportation of Armenians was the work of a small committee who had seized the power ".



Sultan Mehmed VI sentenced the Ottoman leaders who had committed the Armenian genocide to death for crimes against humanity in 1919



Hrant Dink Turkish-Armenian persecuted under Article 301 for discussing the genocide. On 19 January 2007 he was assassinated. In September 2010, the European Court of Human Rights said Turk authorities had violated Dink's right to life by not preventing murder and by not punishing the police
